1. With regard to the statement "MDOT may disqualify a Responder if any of its major participants belong

to more than one Responder's organization", how far down the organizational flow chart does this

statement carry? See RFQ Addendum No. 1 (03/03/06) @ www.gomdot.com .

The Contractor's construction company in its entirety and the Design Firm from which the Lead Design Engineer is employed.

2. The "KEY INDIVIDUALS" are listed as the Project Director, Lead Design Engineer, Construction Manager, Quality Control Manager (Design) and Quality Control Manager (Construction).

Are each of these

considered to be major participants? Yes.

3. There are only a few Bridge Design Engineers in the state who have the experience and background

to qualify and fill the requirements of Lead Bridge Design Engineer. Several of these are partners in a firm

or are associated in some fashion. Can one engineer with a firm be a participant on one Responder's

organization and another engineer with the same firm or an associated firm be a participant with another

Responder's organization? No.

4. The SF330 contains two parts, part I, and part II.

If more than one firm is teaming together, do you want One (1) SF 330 Part One containing information on both firms, or multiple Part One's for each firm. Most RFP's in the past have asked for one Part One, and multiple Part Twos. Usually a Part Two for each firm.

Can you clarify if you want one Part I for the team or one for each team member? This will directly affect the number of pages in the SOQ. **See RFQ Addendum No. 1 (03/03/06)** @ www.gomdot.com.

The RESPONDER shall complete form SF 330. Clarification of the requirements for form SF 330 are as follows:

Part I of Form SF 330 shall be completed by the contracting entity (prime contractor(s)). Section B shall list the contracting entity and the Project Director. Sections C & D shall list all team members identified in the SOQ. Section E shall be completed for each individual identified in the SOQ. Sections F & G shall identify projects completed by the contracting entity.

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Part II of from SF 330 shall be completed by each Architect-Engineering firms for their respective firms, contractors are only required to provide similar profiles in a form of their choosing.

This information may be included in the appendices and will not be counted against the 25-page maximum requirement.
