**Purpose:**

To ensure specified areas along intersection approach legs and across their radii shall be clear of obstructions that might block a driver's view of potentially conflicting vehicles.

**Summary:**

A policy restricting access at intersections to provide adequate sight distance.

Access shall not be permitted (a) across Right-Of-Way acquired for sight distance at the intersection of roadways or (b) within the limits of the radii of intersecting roadways.
