

Bidders are hereby advised that a partial amount of the cold milling material shall remain the property of the State. The contractor shall haul and stockpile the milled material to the locations described below. Adequate equipment must be available to properly stockpile the material. Costs for hauling and stockpiling material, including incidental items, shall be included in other items bid.

1. Two (2) miles of one lane (24 ft. wide) to the Yalobusha County Maintenance Headquarters near Coffeenville.
2. Twelve (12) miles of one lane (24 ft. wide) to the Grenada County Maintenance Headquarters near Grenada.

The remaining cold milling material shall become the property of the contractor.
