Milestone 1 - Interim Completion Date. Milestone 1 is an interim completion date for completion of the work on SR 604, except for growth and coverage. Milestone 1 completion date is a <u>30-day period</u> determined by the Contractor. The 30-day period begins when the Contractor installs the construction signs.

If Milestone 1 is not completed within 30 days, the Contractor shall be assessed a road user cost in an amount of equal to \$5,000 for each calendar day after Milestone 1 until Milestone 1 is completed. In addition, all work on SR 604, except for growth and coverage, shall be completed by November 1, 2008. All work at this site must be completed before starting work at sites on Highway 90. The Engineer shall be given 10-days advanced notice prior to starting work on SR 604.
