Bidders are hereby advised that modified placement techniques should be utilized for all Pay Items from the ALTERNATE GROUP AA NUMBER 1. When 6-inch Inverted Profile Thermoplastic Traffic Stripe is used as the alternate, and is placed in a manner that is not adjacent to a travel lane, the inverted profile will not need to be applied to the markings. The thermoplastic placed in these areas will, however, need to maintain the same typical thickness as thermoplastic placed with inverted profile. The areas of omission will include areas of detail stripe that are not parallel to the adjacent travel lane such as chevron gores and shoulder hashes.
