SUBJECT: Lane Closure Restrictions

Bidders are hereby advised of the following lane closure restrictions.

Work requiring a lane closure shall begin within one (1) hour of completion of the closure set-up. Lane closures will be allowed only at times when work requiring a lane closure is underway except as follows.

Lane closures may remain in place overnight to restrict public access to a section of roadway that is undergoing full depth concrete repair.

Lane closures that remain in place overnight shall comply with the requirements of the plans for Extended Period lane closures.

Changes or variances from the listed restrictions shall be submitted to the Project Engineer for review and approval
