The contract documents do not include an official set of construction plans but may, by reference, include some Standard Drawings or Special Design Drawings. All other references to plans in the contract documents and Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction are to be disregarded.

Work on the project shall consist of the following:

Mill and overlay approximately 6.2 miles of existing asphalt pavement on US 45 from Station 44+00, approximately 0.75 miles south of the Clarke-Lauderdale County Line, to SR 145 at Station 165+00 in Lauderdale County. The EOP is approximately 300 feet south of SR 145 where the asphalt pavement ends and the concrete pavement begins.

The width of the asphalt overlay is twenty-eight (28) feet and the depth is two (2) inches and variable. The existing twenty-four (24) foot wide asphalt pavement shall be milled two (2) inches and inlaid with two (2) inches and variable of HMA, MT, 12.5 mm Mixture.

The existing pavement is be widened two (2) linear feet on each lane as directed by the Engineer. Asphalt for this widening is to be placed full depth, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ", concurrent with the placement of the mainline overlay. Prior to placement of the asphalt, the shoulders are to be bladed to a depth of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to provide a suitable paving surface; the cost of which is to be included in the price bid for other items. Any material excavated from the existing shoulder shall be used to raise the existing shoulder to match the new pavement elevation and any surplus material shall be spread along the edge of the shoulders, foreslopes, or other adjacent areas as directed by the Engineer and will be an absorbed item.

Channelized intersections, cross-overs and county roads are to be milled two (2) inches and inlayed with two (2) inches of HMA, MT, 12.5-mm Mixture. Channelized intersections and county roads shall be overlaid within 48 hours of the day milled.

Guardrail Replacement:

This work shall consist of replacing the guardrail terminal end sections at bridge approaches as shown in the attached table. All guardrail terminal end sections removed are to be replaced the same day and prior to reopening the adjacent lane of traffic. Voids created by the removal of posts, concrete anchors, footing, etc. shall be backfilled in accordance with Section 203 of the

Standard Specifications. Maintenance of existing guardrail, such as tightening loose bolts, shall be required and absorbed in the cost of associated pay items.

Damaged and missing Guardrail Delineators shall be replaced per standard. All costs associated with removal of the existing delineators shall be included in the price.

General Notes:

Failed areas shall be removed and replaced with HMA 12.5 mm, MT as directed by the Engineer. Payment for the pavement removal and the asphalt shall be made under the appropriate pay item.

Potholes that may exist or occur in the existing pavement are to be patched in a timely manner and prior to beginning the asphalt overlay. Patching of potholes shall be considered an absorbed item.

Milling will not begin until an <u>approved</u> asphalt mix design has been received, nor until such time that, in the opinion of the Engineer, weather conditions have been consistently suitable enough to allow placement of the HMA after the milling operations. Milling will be limited to an area in a single lane established by the Engineer which, in his judgment, can be overlaid within 24 hours. The contractor will not exceed that area. <u>The milled lane shall not be opened</u> to traffic until the asphalt has been replaced. All roadway not overlaid the same day due to unforeseen circumstances shall be protected by an overnight lane closure. The cost of all items involved in this closure is to be included in the price bid for Pay Item No. 618-A, Maintenance of Traffic.

The Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement (RAP) material removed by the milling operation shall become the property of the contractor with the exception of 10,000 tons or 50% of the total anticipated quantity, whichever is less, to be stockpiled at the MDOT storage location 1.3 miles north of the EOP in the median of US 45. Unless the Contractor desires otherwise, the Contractor's RAP shall be obtained first. The Contractor shall be required to push the milled material into one stockpile. The Contractor shall be responsible for placing and operating equipment necessary to "push up" the milled material. All costs associated with the hauling, placing, and stockpiling the RAP shall be included in the price bid for cold milling.

Publicly maintained streets are to be paved to the existing right-of-way; privately owned entrances are to be paved as shown in the typical drawings.

Temporary pavement transition joints (paper joints) shall be at least three (3) paper-widths long and shall be adequately maintained. Sand or dirt form the edge of roadway shall not be used as a substitute for treated paper

Existing shoulders are to be raised to match the new pavement elevation by placing variable depth Class 5, Group C, Granular Material on the existing shoulders. Placement of the granular material on the finished asphalt course shall not be permitted. The material shall be bladed, rolled, and compacted to a finished slope of four percent (4%). Placement of this material shall be performed to provide a uniform and compacted shoulder with a minimum amount of material

placed. Removal of the existing shoulder material shall be coincident with the milling/overlaying operation to prevent the possible ponding of water. No payment will be made for blading or removal of the existing shoulder material. Any material excavated from the existing shoulder shall be used to raise the existing shoulder to match the new pavement elevation and any surplus material shall be spread along the edge of the shoulders, foreslopes, or other adjacent areas as directed by the Engineer and will be an absorbed item. The Contractor shall schedule his operations in such a manner to insure that traffic is not subjected to edge drop-offs of two and one-quarter inches $(2^{1}4^{"})$ or greater.

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Ground-In Rumble Stripe will be required on the left and right pavement edge per attached special drawing.

Joints in existing Bridges shall be cleaned and sealed as shown on the attached detail and as directed by the Engineer using Pay Item 508-A Silicone Sealed Joints. This work will include the open joints in the bridge deck and the joints between the bridge deck and the bridge end wall currently sealed with preformed seals. Removal of any existing sealant will not be paid for separately.

Size I Stabilizer Aggregate is to be placed on existing driveways behind asphalt ramps as directed by the Engineer.

Median cross-over delineators shall be placed at all median cross-overs. Prior to placement, existing delineators shall be removed. All costs associated with removal of the existing delineators shall be included in the price of items bid.

Existing raised pavement markers are to be removed prior to beginning the overlay operation. No separate measurement will be made for marker removal; the cost is to be included in the price for items bid.


PAY ITEM NO. 508-A SILICONE SEALED JOINTS L.F.


Typical Sectiõn of Additional Shoulder Paving Required at Guardrail Locations






