

Call 12 Mill and Overlay approximately 3 miles of SR 16 from US 51 to end of 3-Lane in Canton, known as State Project No. MP-5016-45(011) / 304416301 in Madison County.

Q1 Should there be a Construction Signing Detail in the Notice to Bidders?

A1. Yes. It will be added to the contract by addendum.

Q2. The typical shows 2" milling at the toe of curb, what will be done with the asphalt in the curb and gutter?

A2. It will have to be removed from the gutter with a motor grader or other equipment, and will be paid for as cold milling.

Q3. If the asphalt is 2" to 4" thick in the gutter will that require the milling to be 4" to 6" at the face of the curb to accommodate for the 2" shown in the proposal?

A3. No. Milling in curb and gutter sections will be 2 inches thick from the face of the gutter to the face of the gutter. However, if there is asphalt in the gutter section and it begins to ravel during the milling operation, the raveling asphalt in the gutter section shall be removed. Otherwise, the asphalt will remain undisturbed in the gutter section.
