 - I-20 and I-55 – No Lane Closures from 6:30AM to 6:30PM
- Hinds County
 - I-220 – From I-20 to Madison County Line - No Lane Closures from 6:30AM to 6:30PM
- Lauderdale County
 - I20/59 N – From HWY 19 To 22nd Ave. – No Lane Closures from 6:30AM to 6:30PM

Monday through Friday

- Madison County
 - HWY 463 – From Galleria Drive to HWY 22 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
- Rankin County
 - HWY 468 E&W – Under I-20 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
 - HWY 468 E&W From Pearl CL to HWY 475 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
 - US 49 N&S – From RR Bridge to US 80 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
 - US 49 S – From RR Bridge to Scarbrough St – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
 - HWY 475 S – From Int HWY 25/475 to .7 MI South – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM

- US 80 W – From Crossgates Blvd to Park Place – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
- US 80 W – From Value Road to HWY 471 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM – 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM.
- US 80 E – From HWY 468 to Kroger – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
- US 80 W – From Bierdeman Road to HWY 468 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM
- US 80 E – From Flying J to US 49 – No Lane Closures from 6:30 AM– 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM – 6:30 PM

No exceptions to the above requirements will be allowed unless specifically approved by the Project Engineer.

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer a minimum of 12 hours before implementation of any lane or shoulder closure.

No lane closures will be permitted on the following holidays or the day preceding them: New Year's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. In the event that one the above mentioned holidays falls during the weekend or on a Monday, no lane closures will be allowed during that weekend or the Friday immediately preceding that holiday.

If the lane closure restriction listed above is violated, no excuses will be accepted by the Department and the Contractor will be charged a fee of \$500.00 for each full or partial five minute period until the roadway is back in compliance with the lane closure restriction requirement.
