

Call 01 Bridge Repair on SR 16/SR 149 Panther Creek Bridge No. 211.9, known as Federal Aid Project No. STP-0037-04(058) / 107138302 in Yazoo County.

Q1. Our FRP wrap material meets or exceeds the properties of the three FRP products listed on the plans. It has been rigorously tested, including 10,000-hour durability tests required by ICC-ES and CALTRANS. Can you confirm that FRP materials that meet or exceed the properties of the products listed on the plans are approved for use on this project?

A1. No, any product substitution has to be formally submitted to the Director of Structures, State Bridge Engineer for prior approval before construction”.

Q2. What is the purpose of the Turbidity Barrier? No construction activities should disturb the ground. Is the intent to act as containment for the epoxy repair and/or pressure washing?

A2. It will be used as directed by the Engineer.

Q3. Plan sheet 5 Notes (1) shows mounting on double-faced Type III barricade but bid proposal sheet 2-1 indicates bidding 619-G4001 single faced barricades. Which will be the correct item?

A3. See the addendum to the project.
