Bidders are hereby advised that the Standard Specifications may require certain traffic control and permanent safety hardware devices to meet the requirements of the Manual for Assessing Safety Hardware (MASH). However, devices meeting the requirements of NCHRP Report 350 will be allowed until the mandatory effective date for MASH compliance. The following table shows the effective dates for MASH compliant devices.

Temporary work zone devices, including portable barriers manufactured after December 31, 2019, must have been successfully tested to the 2016 Edition of MASH. Such devices manufactured on or before this date and successfully tested to NCHRP Report 350 or the 2009 Edition of MASH may continue to be used throughout their normal service lives.

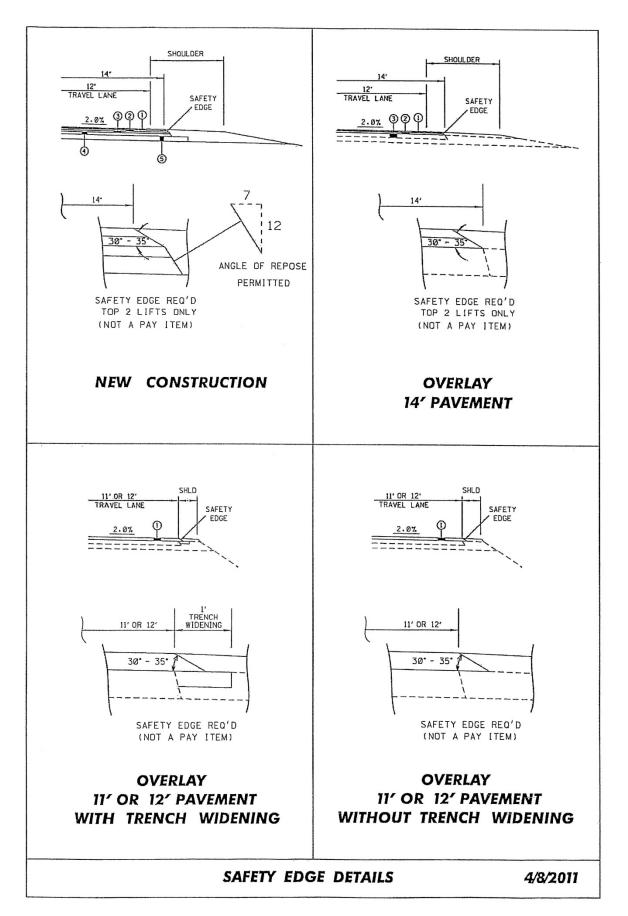

The contract documents do not include an official set of construction plans but may - by reference - include some Standard Drawings when so specified in a Notice to Bidders entitled, "Standard Drawings". All other references to plans in the contract documents and Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction are to be disregarded.

Work on the project shall consist of the following:

<u>SR 184</u> OVERLAY APPROXIMATELY 2.6 MILES OF SR 184 <u>FROM SR 63 to US 45</u> 961+45 to 991+71 BK & 10+00 AH to 117+97

(A) Prior to the overlay, centerline alignment shall be determined by the Contractor by measuring the existing roadway at 500-foot intervals in tangent sections, and 100-foot intervals in horizontal curves.

(B) Cold Mill 1¹/₂" and variable on US 184 at all the transitions including E.O.P., B.O.P., and all tie-ins. All milled areas shall be backfilled with asphalt within 48 hours of milling.

(C) Overlay SR 184 through the curb and gutter section (approximate Sta. 961+45 to Sta. 991+00) with 1¹/₂" of 9.5-mm, MT, asphalt mixture. Prior to the overlay, cold mill SR 184 through the curb and gutter section (approximate Sta. 961+45 to Sta. 991+00), including parking areas as directed by the Project Engineer. All milled material shall be stockpiled at the intersection of Reservoir Road and US 84 as designated by the Engineer and will become property of MDOT. Remove high joints by sawing the pavement full depth, five (5) feet on each side of the center of the high joint and backfill with 19-mm, MT, asphalt and roll to refusal as directed by the Project Engineer. Vibratory rollers will not be permitted within the curb and gutter section. Care shall be taken so that the finished grade allows water to drain into the inlets, and that the asphalt ties flush with the inlets.

Outside of the curb and gutter section (approximate Sta. 991+00 to Sta.991+71 BK, 10+00 AH to Sta. 117+97), overlay SR 184 with 1" of 9.5-mm, MT, asphalt mixture. The Southbound turn lane from US 45 onto SR 184 will also be included in this work. Prior to the overlay in this section, a leveling course of ³/₄" and variable of 9.5-mm, MT, asphalt mixture will be required. Remove any failed areas on the main facility and repair by backfilling with 19-mm, MT, asphalt mixture as directed by the Project Engineer. Removal areas will be marked by MDOT personnel and include but are not limited to areas shown in Table 1. Approximately 1,780 tons of 19-mm,

MT, asphalt will be used for backfill in removal sections. Publicly maintained roads or streets shall be surfaced to the existing R.O.W. Only if they are currently paved; privately owned entrances shall be surfaced a distance of 10 feet and variable from edge of pavement. Any site grading at local roads or drives will not be measured for separate payment but will be considered an absorbed item. Cross slopes shall be maintained to achieve a uniform cross slope of 2%. If water stands when project is complete, the Contractor shall correct at no additional cost to the State. Smoothness incentive/disincentive will be governed by special provision for MRI (mean roughness index). All incentive/disincentive will be based on theoretical tonnage placed on a 12-foot travel lane.

(D) All work to be performed within the curb and gutter section shall be done Sunday through Thursday only, from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. All operations which are performed during the nondaylight hours shall be properly illuminated to allow for the complete performance and inspection of the work. If it is the Project Engineer's opinion that there is not proper lighting for adequate and safe performance and inspection of the work, the Contractor shall make the necessary adjustments to improve the lighting. The cost for these adjustments shall be absorbed by the Contractor. Lighting systems shall be positioned such that they do not cause glare to drivers or nearby homes and businesses. When necessary, the lighting systems shall include screening to minimize glare. Prior to the initial start of nighttime operations, a lighting plan shall be submitted to the Project Engineer for review and approval in accordance with Section 680. The Project Engineer shall have fourteen (14) days in which to review the lighting plan. No nighttime construction shall commence until the lighting plan has been approved in writing. The lighting system shall be considered incidental to other contract items and no direct payment will be made for such.

(E) Raise the existing shoulders to match the new pavement elevation by placing 2¹/₄" and variable depth 825B Crushed Stone on the shoulders. Placement of the crushed stone on the finished surface course shall not be permitted. The material shall be bladed, rolled and compacted to a finished slope of 4% where practical. Shoulders with existing adequate shoulder material in place shall be bladed to a slope of 4%, the cost of which shall be included in the prices of other items bid.

(F) Type 3 Object Markers are to be placed with two (2) markers per posts at pipe headwalls and one marker per post (two (2) posts each side of roadway) at box headwalls. Object markers will be paid under Pay Items 630-G005 and 630-G006 as applicable.

(G) Temporary striping shall conform to finished stripe specifications for alignment, neatness, reflectivity, and straightness. All permanent pavement markings are to be hot thermoplastic. Edge lines will be placed so as to maintain the original lane width. Special care should be taken for the placement of Thermoplastic Detail Stripe along the edge of pavement at turn-outs on all local roads and along tapers where Detail Stripe is required as per Typical PMD-1.

(H) Raised pavement markers will be placed as per sheet PM-1 of the Standard Drawings. Any removal of existing raised pavement markers or rumble bars shall be considered an absorbed item. Only flexible adhesive shall be allowed for placement of raised pavement markers meeting the requirements of Subsection 720.03.7.7.


The Contractor shall erect and maintain construction signing, and provide all signs and traffic handling devices, and shall provide two portable R16-3 signs per work zone or lane closure in addition to signs required by standard drawings in accordance with <u>Manual Uniform Traffic</u> <u>Control Devices (MUTCD)</u>. The cost is to be included in the price bid for pay item No. 618-A, Maintenance of Traffic.

Incidental work such as removing vegetation, shaping and compaction of shoulder, removing excess asphalt material, project clean-up, and other incidental work necessary to complete the project will not be measured for separate payment, but will be included in other bid items, and must be performed during the operating hours for this project.






TYPICAL SECTION STA. 991+00 TO 991+71 BK STA. 10+00 AH TO 117+97







TYPICAL MILLED TRANSITION AT BRIDGE ABUT. OR PAVEMENT IN PLACE





TYPICAL FOR PAVED TAPER AT LOCAL ROADS










- 21 W20-1 "AHEAD" signs required. One (1) W20-1 "AHEAD" sign is required at each local road or street entering the project.
- <u>16</u> R4-1 "DO NOT PASS" signs required.
- R4-2 "PASS WITH CARE" signs required.
- 16 W14-3 "NO PASSING ZONE" signs required.
- 4 R16-3 "SPEEDING FINES DOUBLED" signs required.


R4-1 "DO NOT PASS", R4-2 "PASS WITH CARE", and W14-3 "NO PASSING ZONE" signs are required in accordance with Subsection 618.03.3, this drawing, and as specified in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. If no passing zones are 1,000 feet or more, additional "DO NOT PASS" signs shall be installed.

R16-3 signs shall be spaced in accordance with sheet titled "Location of R16-3 Signs".

All Construction signing is included in the bid for Pay Item 618-A, Maintenance of Traffic. Fluorescent orange sheeting shall be used on all construction and traffic control signs except for R16-3, R4-1 and R4-2 signs which shall be black legend and border on white background.

Two portable R-16-3 signs are required per work zone or lane closure in addition to the signs required by MUTCD.
