The contract documents do not include an official set of construction plans but may, by reference, include some Standard Drawings when so specified in a Notice to Bidders entitled, "Standard Drawings." All other references to plans in the contract documents and Standard Specification for Road and Bridge Construction are to be disregarded.

Minor changes in detail of design or construction procedure may be authorized by the Director of Structures, State Bridge Engineer provided such changes will not be cause for contract price adjustment. Work for which no pay item is provided will not be paid for directly and shall therefore be considered an absorbed item of work.

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to protect existing structures from damage which might occur during construction. The Contractor shall replace or repair, as directed by the Engineer, any structures damaged during the life of the contract. No payment will be made for replacement or repair of damaged items.

During construction, care shall be exercised to ensure that no debris falls onto the roadway under the structure. All debris shall become the property of the Contractor and shall be removed from the construction site.

Work on the project shall consist of the following:

Replace Sign Truss and Sign Panels

Approximate location of the sign truss and sign panels to be replaced is 900 feet East of Ellis Avenue on I-20 West Bound.

Sign truss and components shall be Contractor Designed in accordance with Section 630 of the Standard Specification and the attached Detail Plan Sheets. No change of the details will be permitted except by written approval of the Director of Structures, State Bridge Engineer. Minor changes in details of design or construction may be authorized by the Director of Structures, State Bridge Engineer, provided such changes will not be cause for contract price adjustment.

Shop drawings of the truss structure shall be submitted in duplicate to the Director of Structures, State Bridge Engineer, for approval prior to the fabrication of the truss and in accordance with Subsection 810.02.2 of the Standard Specifications. The shop drawings shall show the foundation elevations necessary to insure minimum vertical clearances. The method used to provide the

required parabolic camber (see camber diagrams) shall be shown on the shop drawings.

Steel sign truss and sign panels shall be installed per the reviewed shop drawing details.

Reinforcing steel shall be ASTM A615, Grade 60, unless otherwise noted. Bar bending details shall be in accordance with "Manual of Standard Practice for Detailing Reinforced Concrete Structures" (ACI 31 5R-94). Reinforcement in the new sign truss foundations will not be directly paid for, it shall be considered an absorbed item.

All welding shall be performed in the shop by certified welders and in accordance with ANSL/AWS D1.1. Grinding of welds on seamed pipes will not be required; however, good shop practices shall be followed in the appearance of the weld.

Payment for this work shall be made under Pay Item No. 630-I, Metal Overhead Sign Supports, Assembly No. 1, Contractor Designed.

Work for which no pay item is provided in the proposal will not be paid for directly and compensation, therefore, will be included in the prices and payments for bid items.


