- Q2. Since the bike/walking trail will not be chemically treated, what will the density requirements be on the 12' bike/walking trail?
- A2. The density requirements for asphalt will be the same as for the chemically treated areas.
- Q3. Are pre-cast drainage structures allowed with cast in place tops?
- A3. Yes, in accordance with Subsection 601.02.3 of the 2017 Standard Specifications and Sheets PCU-1 and PCU-2 in the plans.
- Q4. Is burning of trees and stumps within the limits of the ROW acceptable?
- A4. Burning of trees and stumps shall be in accordance with Subsection 107.22.2 of the 2017 Standard Specifications.
- Q5. **1.** Where is the 665-A002 Video Encoder, Type A to be deployed? **2.** What camera will it be transmitting? The PTZ camera on TSI-1 isn't indicated to be analog; hence, by requirement it is an IP camera.

- Q6. Item 307-S001 in the plans has a quantity of 8893 gallons; however, the EBS file for this item has a quantity of 26,678 gallons which appears to be an error.

- Q7. Item 603-A023 36" Steel Pipe Jacked or Bored and Item 603-A018 30" Steel Pipe Jacked or Bored both have a wall thickness of 0.500" specified; however, note 32 on sheet GN-2 states that the wall thickness should be 0.875". Please clarify.

- Q8. Can traffic run on a milled surface?
- A8. Traffic will be permitted on the milled surface at tie-in locations; however, traffic will <u>not</u> be permitted on the milled surface on mainline areas.
