Thank you.
- A2. The rust preventative compound shall meet the requirements of Military Specifications MIL-C-11796C. Technical data sheets for the Contractor's elected product shall provide the application process. Please refer the section 907-845.03.8.1 of proposal for locations the rust preventative compound is to be used.
- Q3. Are we safe to assume that the rust preventative material is not needed on these bridges either?
