- Q2. Will construction joints be allowed in the concrete buttress headwall so that this headwall can be constructed in sections? If so, what is the minimum joint spacing allowed?
- A2. Yes, construction joints will be allowed. The Contractor shall submit proposed construction joint locations for approval to the Project Engineer.
- Q3. There are some blue markers/pipes in the west bound lane that we assume are marking a water line. Does MDOT have any details on this or other Utilities that may affect the project?
- A3. These are pipes installed by the Geotechnical Branch during their investigation of the slide. They are sacrificial and will be removed by the Contractor.
