- Q2. Is geotextile fabric required to be installed underneath the riprap?
- A2. See addendum.
- Q3. Is there any mandatory pre-bid meeting required for Call 10 to be in attendance?
- A3. No.
- Q4. **1.**) What will the temporary construction clearance above the tracks be? Page 8002 does not indicate what this Temp. Const. Clearance will be, it just indicates the existing clearance; and the paint containment requires a min. of 3' below the existing beam. **2.**) How many trains pass daily through this route?
- A4. **1.**) As per the Railroad Notes on Sheet 8002, "Vertical and horizontal clearances during construction shall adhere to minimum temporary construction clearance requirements as specified by the Railroad". **2.**) Bidders are advised to contact the Railroad directly.
- Q5. Does the scope of work include removing any armor from existing joints? If so, how will we be paid for this item and what will we use to repair?
- A5. Bridge joint armor will not be removed.
- Q6. Will there be a requirement for Type 1 saw cuts for the new Type 1 joints?
