SUBJECT: Lane Closure Restrictions

PROJECT: IM-0069-04(003) 108582/301 & IM-0069-04(004) 108583/301 – Desoto County

Bidders are hereby advised that lane closures for construction operations will not be allowed Northbound during the hours of 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM Monday through Friday, Southbound during the hours of 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM Monday through Thursday and Southbound during the hours of 2:00 PM to 7:00 PM on Friday.

- A minimum of one mainline travel lane shall remain open to traffic.
- A maximum of two lanes may be closed in each direction (Northbound and Southbound).
- When more than one lane is closed they shall be adjacent.
- All lane closures shall be adjacent to the shoulder.

No exceptions to the above requirements will be allowed without written approval by the Engineer. Also, construction activities will be conducted as per section 108.04 of the 2017 Standard Specifications. If any of the work restrictions listed above are violated, the Contractor will be charged a fee of **\$500.00** for each full or partial five minute period until the roadway is back in compliance with the work restrictions listed above.
