**SUBJECT: Additional Milling Requirements** 

Bidders are hereby advised that when the main lanes of SR 15, SR 46 and SR 782 are fine milled, traffic will be allowed to run on a milled surface for up to seven (7) calendar days. The Contractor will be assessed a penalty of \$5,000 per calendar day afterwards until the milled surfaces are covered with the next lift of asphalt. It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to ensure that the milling operations do not commence until such time as forecasted weather conditions are suitable enough to allow the placement of the asphalt pavement after the milling operations.

Bidders are also advised that milling on paved local roads and the Natchez Trace must be covered within thirty (30) calendar days.

Bidders are further advised that milling will occur at the tie-ins of each BOP & EOP, bridge ends, paved local roads and the Natchez trace. Mainline transitions will be approximately 150'.
