Call 01 Slide Repair on I-55 Southbound South of Hazlehurst at Tower Road Interchange, known as Federal Aid Project No. STP-0055-01(119) / 108495301 in Copiah County.

- Q1. Can we get the soil boring results for this project?
- A1. Soil borings were not done for this project.
- Q2. Will the contractor be allowed to drive the piles by usage of a vibratory hammer, or will an impact hammer be required to drive the piles?
- A2. Usage of a vibratory hammer will be allowed.
- Q3. 605-W001 Filter Material for Combination Storm Drain and/or Underdrains, Type A, FM (GY) 1,100.0 CY: Drawing \$PG\$ notes "crushed stone" for this area. Is this material required to be crushed stone meeting the gradation requirements of 605-W001 Filter Material for Combination Storm Drain and/or Underdrains, Type A, FM, or will a washed gravel material be allowed?
- A3. A washed gravel material will NOT be allowed. It states in Section H of the Scope of Work, "The drainage layer will be backfilled with 605-W001 Filter Material for Underdrains, Type A, FM Size #57."
- Q4. Even though soil borings were not done for the project, does the Department have a soil profile that it anticipates to be in the location of the pile?
- A4. No.
