- Q1. 1.) Will the 4 lbs/ft Square Tube Post use the concrete installation detail or the direct driven soil installation detail?
 2.) Will a line item for concrete be added?
 3.) Will the 2 lbs/ft Square Tube Post be direct driven or utilize the Omni Sleeve installation?
 4.) Does linear footage of post/bases below ground count towards quantity totals for the pay item?
 5.) Are there any Maintenance of Traffic requirements?
- A1. 1.) 4lb/ft (2.5") Square Tube Posts will require concrete footings with anchor stubs. 2.) No. As detailed in Notice to Bidders 3594, the cost of Class "B" Concrete footing for replacement sign is to be absorbed in other items. 3.) 2lb/ft (2.0") Square Tube Posts will utilize the Omni Sleeve installation. 4.) The post lengths are estimated from the top of the post to three feet into the ground. 5.) Notice to Bidders 3594 states "The Contractor shall also be responsible for maintenance of traffic in accordance with MDOT Standard Drawings and/or other Special Design sheets that may be included in this proposal." MDOT Standard Drawings for Traffic Control are also included in Notice to Bidders 3117.
- Q2. Will digital printing of highway signs be permitted if certified by reflective sheeting manufacturer?
