




THE EVERY DAY COUNTS (EDC) EXCHANGE SESSION I

TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT (TIM) TRAINING

Traffic Incident Management (TIM) is a planned and coordinated multidisciplinary practice designed to detect, respond to, and clear traffic incidents that allows traffic flow to be restored safely and quickly as possible. Since effective TIM is critical to ensure improved responder and motorist safety, reduced traffic congestion, and enhanced system performance and reliability, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is deploying a standardized, and cost-effective training framework and curriculum that are vital to spur widespread adoption of best practices and to promote consistency in application. Tier I training includes on-scene activities including detection/verification, response, site management, clearance/removal, and traffic management with a focus on responder safety. Responders from different TIM discipline, including Law Enforcement, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Fire and Rescue, Department of Transportation, Towing and Recovery providers, and Notification and Dispatch are encouraged to attend this Exchange.

As part of the EDC Initiative, the FHWA, and the Mississippi Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP), is launching the EDC Exchange. This program is a new outreach and training communication for connecting local and tribal transportation officials, the FHWA, the State Departments of Transportation, and other stakeholders involved in deploying EDC initiatives.
