SUPPLEMENT TO SPECIAL PROVISION NO. 907-107-10 LPA

SUBJECT: Contractor's Erosion Control Plan

Delete the first paragraph of Subsection 907-107.22.1 on page 1, and substitute the following.

If an early Notice to Proceed is desired, the Contractor's Erosion Control Plan should be submitted to the Engineer as soon as possible after execution of the contract, since an approved erosion control plan is required for an early Notice to Proceed. The plan shall utilize temporary measures and permanent erosion control features to provide acceptable controls during all stages of construction.

Delete the first sentence of the second paragraph of Subsection 907-107.22.1 on page 1, and substitute the following.

The contractor is allowed 60 calendar days, the time between the execution of the contract and Notice to Proceed/Beginning of Contract Time for the submittal and concurrence of the Contractor's erosion control plan, MDOT's review of the plan, and any revisions that may be necessary.

Delete the paragraph under Subsection 907-107.22.2 on page 2, and substitute the following.

Unless otherwise determined by the Engineer from a study of overall job conditions, the exposed surface area of erodible material at any one time on this project shall not exceed 19 acres without prior approval by the Engineer.
