There are six types of statewide maps available for purchase. See our map prices list above for pricing information.

Legal Truck Weight Limits: This map shows the weight limits allowed on each state maintained highway and legal weight limits on posted bridges. Maximum allowable axle loads and gross vehicle weight limits are also shown. Updates are made on a continual basis.

General Highway Maps: The General Highway State map shows among other things the county outlines, locations of cities and towns, the major public roads, the major streams and lakes, railroads, national forest boundaries, airports, state and national parks and the locations of the universities.

The State Designated - State Maintained: This map is updated annually to reflect the public roads that comprise the designated highway system as enacted by the State Legislature and also those routes that are maintained by the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

County Outline State Map: The county outline state map shows the county boundaries for each of the counties. Maps are available on a scale of 1' = 12 miles.

The General Highway County: The map shows all public roads except those shown on the city maps. Other features include political boundaries, sections, township and range lines, streams, lakes, airports and railroads. The General Highway County Map is available in scales of 1' = 1 mile. There are also some counties available with road names identified.

General Highway County Map Atlas: A bound atlas of all 82 counties is available for maps with a scale of 1' = 2 miles.

- **Incorporated areas:** City maps are available for all incorporated areas. These maps show the public roads and streets within the corporate limits and within highly congested areas surrounding the cities. This map also shows sections, townships and range lines, streams and lakes, airports and railroads and may be obtained singly or within a map atlas.
- **State, County and Urban maps** are available in computer digital graphic files. All county and city maps are not currently available in standard micro station format. These maps are 20.00 dollars each and are the same price regardless of type, be they State, County, City or Urban Maps.

State, County, City and Urban Maps are available in computer digital graphic files. All county and city maps are not currently available in digital format. Digital maps are available in standard Micro Station Format. DGN is a binary file format that requires Micro Station PC software.

Mississippi Public Roads Selected Statistics: Extent, Travel and Designation

This annual report provides the public road length and annual vehicle distance traveled in rural and urban areas for each county. Additional information is summarized by functional classification and maintained responsibility. Appendices include route locations and descriptions of: Interstate, US and Mississippi Highways, loops and spurs, and memorial highways and bridges. Maps of district locations, designated highway systems, and memorial highway systems are also included. Vehicle Classification count data and continuous traffic recorder data are also presented in this publication.
