The contract documents do not include an official set of construction plans, but may, by reference, include some Standard Drawings when so specified in a Notice to Bidders entitled "Standard Drawings."

In general, the work to be accomplished using the pay items and corresponding specifications set forth in the contract is for furnishing of material and the placement of pavement markings in accordance with the Standard Specifications, special provisions and the enclosed drawings as applicable. Maps are included of each county within the District showing routes or segments of routes on which pavement markings are to be placed. Estimated quantities are shown by route for each county.

<u>NOTE</u>: Raised pavement markers will be place 80 feet apart in tangents and 40 feet apart in curves. Ten clear/clear markers will be placed at each break in the continuous white edge stripe in the area of local roads. There will be five clear/clear markers on each side of the local road, placed 10 feet on centers.

The Contractor and project engineer will survey each route in an attempt to determine the proper lane width for placing the white edge line. The edges on these routes will likely be variable throughout, and the premise of this project is to get all of the 6-inch edge line on the pavement.

Loose existing material shall be removed by brooming or other approved methods prior to the placement of the new pavement markings. This work will not be measured for separate payment. Costs associated with this work shall be included in the unit prices of other items bid.

The Contractor shall be responsible for establishing all the necessary controls to provide pavement surface cleaning or other preparation necessary to insure a proper bond prior to placement of the pavement markings. The Contractor is also responsible for minor blading of the shoulders to establish a suitable area for restriping; this is not meant to be blading the entire shoulder width, but only that directly related to stripe placement. This work will not be measured for separate payment. Costs associated with this work shall be included in the unit prices of other items bid.

<u>NOTE</u>: The existing stripe on bridges shall be removed prior to new stripe being placed. Work associated with removal of stripe shall be absorbed in other items bid. Thermoplastic will be placed on bridges in accordance with the latest specifications.

The Contractor shall erect and maintain the necessary construction signing and provide all signs and traffic handling devices necessary to safely maintain traffic around and through the work areas

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in accordance with the Standard Specifications, special provisions, enclosed drawings, and the latest edition of the MUTCD. Payment shall be made under pay item 618-A: Maintenance of Traffic.

Incidental work that is necessary to complete the work shall not be measured for separate payment, and the cost shall be included in the items bid.

NOTE: The existing raised pavement markers will NOT have to be removed.
