Call 07 Bridge Painting on I-20 over Valley Street (Bridge Nos. 44.1A & 44.1B) & on I-55 over McDowell Road (Bridge No. 90.7), known as Federal Aid Project Nos. NHPP-0020-01(252) / 108289301 & NHPP-0055-02(259) / 108290301 in Hinds County.

- Q1. Are there as built drawings available for this, the drawings that were included in the proposal are not enough for us to bid accurately.
- A1. As-built drawings may be downloaded at the following link:

- Q2. Weather and Temp Limitations: It states that, "Coatings shall not be applied when contamination from rainfall is imminent." If the bridge is fully contained and it is not raining, but states there is a chance for rain, is MDOT stating the contractor shall not even attempt to coat the steel?
- A2. Yes.
- Q3. Are there any minimum clearance height restrictions on any of the 3 structures for underneath on Valley Street or McDowell Road?
- A3. Minimum clearance is 15'-6" or greater.
- Q4. Stripe Coat: Is each coat to receive stripe coat or just intermediate coat?
- A4. Each coat.
- Q5. The proposal states no lane closures during the day, but it doesn't state what road MDOT is specifying for these restrictions. Is MDOT referring to I-20, I-55, Valley Street, or McDowell Road?
- A5. Notice to Bidders No. 3955, entitled "Lane Closure Restrictions" only applies to I-20 and I-55.
- Q6. Line Item # 0130, 907-823-B001 Saw Cut, Type I shows a quantity of 6,944-LF. PDF Page 108 of the project documents is showing 160-LF. Is this quantity correct?
- A6. Page 107 (PDF Page 108) of the proposal was included for informational purposes only, and is from a previous project. The quantity of 6,944 LF is the total quantity for all bridges.
- Q7. The bridges over Valley Street have vertical armor in a few of the joints. The job doesn't appear to be set up for any armor removal. Can you verify we are not removing vertical armor from the joints?
- A7. Vertical armor will not be removed.

- Q8. This project has a 0% DBE goal, does that mean the OCR-481 form does not need to be submitted?
- A8. Yes.
- Q9. What are the existing vertical clearances at structure 44.1 A and B at Raymond Rd. and Valley St.? What is the existing vertical clearance at structure 90.7 at E. McDowell Rd?
- A9. The minimum clearances are listed below:

44.1A over Valley St.: 20.76'

44.1A over Raymond Rd.: 19.15'

44.1B over Valley St.: 16.04'

44.1B over Raymond Rd.: 18.68'

90.7 over McDowell Rd.: 16.31'

- Q10. We are aware of the special fuel tax on this project. Is there a Business & Occupation tax (B & O tax) or similar tax associated with this project?
- A10. This should be directed to the Mississippi Department of Revenue.
- Q11. What are the lane restrictions, if any, on Raymond Rd., Valley St., and E. McDowell Rd.?
- A11. See Answer #5.
