

**Call 15 Widen & Overlay approximately 11 miles on SR 29 from West ROW Limits of I-59 in Ellisville to SR 28 and Mill & Overlay the intersection of SR 15 and US 84 in Laurel & I-59 Ramps at Exit 96 A, Exit 96 B (Cook Ave.), and Exit 97 (US 84 East), known as State Project Nos. SP-0241-00(014) / 108924301 & SP-0059-02(115) / 108925301 in Jones County.**

Q1. Can you define the limits of the milling at the intersection of SR 588 and SR 29? The proposal states "milling a depth of 1.5" from STA 10+00 to STA 21+50 and a portion of SR 588 where concrete islands are present".

A1. SR 29 will be milled from Station 10+00 to Station 21+50. The portion of SR 588 is a total length of 750 feet from the middle of the intersection. Hal Crocker Road will be milled 100 feet from the middle of the intersection.
