The contract documents do not include an official set of construction plans, but may, by reference, include some Standard Drawings when so specified in a Notice to Bidders entitled, "Standard Drawings."

The work to be accomplished using the pay items and corresponding specifications set forth in the contract is to remove dead and/or dying trees from the Right-of-Way of State Routes, US Highways, and US Interstates as described and noted herein as applicable.

Please see the attached county maps for the routes to be addressed along with any omitted sections.


Work on the Project shall consist of the following:

#### **Interstate Routes:**

- 1. Any questions or verification of right-of-way limits for trees to be removed shall be directed to the Project Engineer.
- 2. Cut all dead or dying trees in the apparent right-of-way.
- 3. All trees cut or that were already downed must be mulched in place or be removed from the highway right-of-way.
- 4. Mulch shall not be left in piles but spread to a maximum depth of three inches (3").
- 5. Any stumps outside of the standing tree line shall be ground or cut to the ground line.
- 6. Any stumps on the southeast quadrant and the northeast quadrant of the interchange at Exit 48 shall be ground or cut to the ground line.
- 7. No excavating of stumps or unnecessary disturbing of the ground will be allowed.
- 8. Any damage to the slopes and other right-of-way will be the responsibility of the Contractor to repair. This includes any regrading of ditches and slopes, grassing, or any other repair needed. All ditches and slopes shall be restored to the previous conditions. Contractor shall take all precautions not to place any mulch in ditches and on the shoulders/slopes on the roadway side of the ditches.
- 9. If a Contractor chooses to remove any downed trees, it is the responsibility of the Contractor to ensure that all necessary requirements are met including but not limited to all permits.
- 10. The Log Miles shall be measured separately along the Northbound outside lanes, the Southbound outside lanes, and the full width of the median. For example, from Log Mile 1.0 to 2.0 you will measure 1.0 mile of random clearing for the northbound outside; 1.0 mile of random clearing for the southbound outside; and 1.0 mile of Random Clearing for the median. This will give you a total of 3.0 miles of random clearing for Log Mile 1.0 to 2.0.

- 11. All costs associated with cutting, mulching, removal, stump grinding, or any other work associated with the dead tree removal shall be included in the pay item for random clearing (per log mile).
- 12. All work associated with traffic control shall be included in the pay item maintenance of traffic per lump sum.
- 13. All work associated with mobilization, remobilization, or demobilization shall be included in the pay item for mobilization.

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to protect the roadway and all existing structures, such as bridges, culverts, signs, and curbs, from damage occurring as a result of the Contractor's operations. Damages to existing structures caused by the Contractor's operations shall be repaired or replaced at no cost to the Department.

MDOT District 7 hosted a Voluntary Pre-Bid Meeting for all potential Bidders on January 22, 2025. The following are the minutes of the Pre-Bid Meeting:

## Minutes for Pre-Bid Meeting for District 7 Tree Removal Projects January 22, 2024

#### **General Discussion of Projects:**

- What it is: Dead trees, both pine and deciduous All dead and dying trees are to be cut from MDOT ROW and mulched in place.
- What it isn't: Clearing/delimbing No living trees are included in this scope of work.
- Traffic Control: Must be a priority (including certifications) MDOT has discussed hosting/schedule traffic control classes if a contractor secures the contract and needs certification. Contractor would have to pay cost of attendance/certification.
- Discussion of Pay items: How the District arrived at this item and what is our intention. –
  Using the available pay items and understanding that MDOT pays estimates monthly, it was
  decided to use a per mile pay item. It is likely that a Contractor will view this as a "lump
  sum" or "total cost" type of project and those costs would be averaged out "per mile". This
  ensures that every mile of every route is addressed and that the Department is able to pay
  an accurate estimate on a monthly basis.
- Interstate overview: Lane/Log Mile x3 Due to the size and scope of the work, the Interstate is set up for 3 payments per Log mile. (Outside Northbound/ Median/ Outside Southbound). This is again to let a contractor work in areas and still be paid a verifiable amount monthly.
- 2-lane/4/lane overview: Lane/Log mile x1 2 lane and 4 lane payments will be paid per mile and that will include left and right of the roadway. US 84 east of Collins is the only 4-lane section with trees in the median and that median section will also be included in the per mile cost.
- Discussion of Addendums Time and Pay Item Some addendums are already in place: Time adjustments – Completion Dates have been moved up to October 17, 2025. These trees are dangerous and effectively an emergency. The Department needs these removed in an expedited timeframe. Highway Railway Provisions – Pay item has been removed. We will not encroach on Railroad ROW. Future Addendum – The Interstate project total will be reduced due to omitting sections already under contract.

#### **Notes from Civil Rights**

 Andrea Hendricks and Stacy Slay – This is a state funded project and there will be no DBE goal.

#### O/A

- Discussion of the "Omitted Sections" that will be shown on the Interstate Project- The
  Department has contracts in place for those sections of interstate and clearing (both dead
  and random/alive) will be addressed in those current contracts. No work within those
  sections will be considered for these projects.
- Stump Grinding Stumps that are outside standing tree lines must be ground. Anything that is within a normal maintenance or mowing area should be ground. For the interstate project it is anticipated that most stumps in the median would be ground for the ability to access the amount of trees impacted in that area. For 2-lane / 4-lane routes will use an "inside/outside" tree line approach to determine grinding.
- If a tree dies later in the project will the contractor be asked to go back and remove?

  No, once it is agreed that an area has been cleared and an estimate has been processed for that section, the contractor will not be required to go back.
- Will there be fuel adjustments? No, there is no haul included so there is no fuel adjustment costs for the contract.
- If there is a dead tree behind live trees how should it be accessed? Live trees can not be cut and all dead trees must be taken down. Some common sense approaches will be considered when it comes to removing trees that are in wooded areas. The dead tree must come down, but if it would cause more damage to the ROW to remove that tree that it would to leave it down and out of sight, considerations will be made.
- Can multiple crews be working on contracts? YES! It is the Departments anticipation that multiple crews will work on these projects in order to meet the deadlines. The Department also understands that there are a wide range of interested parties in these contracts both large and small and it is anticipated that many interested parties may work as subcontractors on these contracts. That type of work is encouraged to help the Department arrive at the best possible cost.
- Is advance signage and bulletin board required? No we will work under standard temporary lane closures. No bulletin board requirements as this is State funded.
