Minutes for Pre-Bid Meeting for District 3 Tree Removal Projects April 7, 2025

General Discussion of Projects:

- Scope: All dead and dying trees are to be cut from MDOT ROW and mulched or removed.
 - o Trees already down are to be removed by mulching or hauling off. No healthy trees are to be removed.
 - o Random clearing is done by the log mile. Interstate log mile will be Right, Left and Median. (x3). Non-Interstate log mile will be each. (1)
- Traffic Control: must be done and is part of the Contract. It shall be submitted with an app. See NTB 4702.

Notes From Contract Administration:

- Neal Dougherty Provided detailed information regarding the MDOT bid processes including securing bid bonds and how to submit a bid. He can share the power point presentation with interested parties.

Civil Rights:

• This is a state funded project and there will be no DBE goal.

Q/A

- Who determines if trees are dead or not Project Engineer or their representative
- If a tree dies later in the project will the Contractor be asked to go back and remove? No, the Contractor after finishing an area, before moving on, should conduct a final inspection with the Project Engineer or their representative. Stay in good communication with the Project Engineer.
- Will the inspector mark the trees to be removed? No, the Project Engineer or their representative will ride with the Contractor to set expectations.
- Can multiple crews work at the same time? Yes
- **Stump Grinding:** Stumps shall be cut or ground to below ground line, so mowers can mow. Mulch cannot be more than 3" thick spread as far as needed within the ROW. Be mindful of creating ruts.
- Width of Shoulders: Interstate has plenty of ROW. Non-Interstate has a minimum of 30'.
 Some apparent ROW on non-interstate routes can be determined by fence line or utility poles.

Minutes for Pre-Bid Meeting for District 3 Tree Removal Projects April 7, 2025

- Who to Contact: in the southern region of the District, it will be Justin Hynum and in the central region it will be Heath Patterson.
- **Road Closures:** will be allowed in 20-minute increments on 2 lane roads, if longer time is needed, open the road for 20 minutes then close again. No LD's for longer increments.
- Will we remove dead trees outside of the ROW? No
- **Hauling of Debris:** Contractors are responsible for finding dump sites and obtaining permits and landowners' permission. Require letter for wetlands.
- Do we have an estimate of how many trees are already down in the areas to be cleared? No, we do not, it is recommended that you ride and look. The southern region is higher than the central region, but it does have more designated areas.
- **Any specific area for storing equipment?** Nothing is designated, make sure all equipment is at least 30' off the travel lane.
- Fuel Adjustment? No, there is no fuel adjustment set up for this job.
- **Burning of trees:** These trees are not classified as "storm" trees. They cannot be removed and burned. DEQ will not issue a burn permit for these trees. Mulch or landfill only.
