- Q1. We have an ongoing hydro-demolition project over KCS RR, and it has taken 6 months to get a Demolition Plan approved. Would MDOT consider delaying the NTP date to allow the Contractor more time given the extensive lead times associated with working with KCS RR?
- A1. Bidders are advised to bid as per the Contract Documents. If delays occur due to the Railroad approval process, the Contractor may submit a request for an extension of time for review.
- Q2. Can MDOT provide a quantity breakdown of the Removal of Joint Material item 202-B169?

- Q3. **1.)** Will notice to bidders 20, temp beam bracing be required on this project? If so will it be isolated to the span over the railroad only? **2.)** Will rail flaggers be needed for the entire project or just when working directly over the span where the railroad crosses?
- A3. **1.)** See Addendum 1. **2.)** It is the responsibility of the Contractor to coordinate with the Railroad regarding flagging requirements.
