**PROJECT: MP-1145-59(004) / 308838-301000 – Prentiss County**

Bidders are hereby advised that traffic **WILL NOT** be allowed on the milled surface of mainline SR 145. In areas where daytime work is allowed, all milled areas shall be covered by Asphalt Pavement by the end of the day that milling is performed unless otherwise noted herein. In areas where night work is required, all milled areas shall be covered by Asphalt Pavement by the end of the night that milling is performed unless otherwise noted herein. Prior to paving, milled areas shall be thoroughly swept to ensure fines and other debris have been removed from the milled surface.

If the lane closure restrictions listed above are violated, the Contractor will be charged a fee of **\$500.00** for each full or partial five minute period until the roadway is back in compliance with the lane closure restriction requirement.

For the purposes of this contract, official time shall be the announced time available at the Tupelo area telephone number (662) 842-8422.

Bidders are also advised that milling on paved local roads must be covered within thirty (30) calendar days.

Bidders are hereby advised of the following lane closure restrictions and additional work requirements:

**Unless otherwise noted herein or specific written permission is allowed by the Engineer, the following conditions apply for work from Ellis Street to the E.O.P. along with all the intersections within these limits. These conditions will be in effect throughout the life of the project.**

**No Lane Closures allowed for any reason:**

- Daily from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday through Sunday

**Lane Closures and Night Work allowed:**

- 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM the following day, Monday through Thursday

**No work will be allowed at any time on Friday and/or Saturday.**

**All night work shall be in accordance with Section 680 – Portable Construction Lighting.**

Also, no lane closures will be permitted on the following holidays or the day preceding them: New Year's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. In the event that one of the above mentioned holidays falls during the weekend or on a Monday, no lane closures will be allowed during that weekend or the Friday immediately preceding that holiday.

If the lane closure restrictions listed above are violated, the Contractor will be charged a fee of **\$500.00** for each full or partial five minute period until the roadway is back in compliance with the lane closure restriction requirement.
