

MDOT WEB PORTAL TERMS OF USE

Subject to the following terms, conditions and policies, users are granted non-commercial short-term non-exclusive revocable use of the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) Web Portal resources including: *mdot.ms.gov, *mdot.state.ms.us, gomdot.com, and *mdottraffic.com. The following represents practices and procedures of MDOT's Web Portal resources. This Terms of Use and Privacy Policy shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi including the Mississippi Public Records Act. You also consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Hinds County, Mississippi, and the exercise of personal jurisdiction of the courts therein.

ACCESS

Users may access and use MDOT's web sites, content, and services only in the manner presented by MDOT, and MDOT computers and network services offered within the MDOT Web Portal (mdot.ms.gov, mdottraffic.com, and associated social media accounts) only in the manner expressly permitted by MDOT. Except for this specific limited use, MDOT does not convey any interest in or to the MDOT Web Portal, information or data available via the MDOT Web Portal, content, services or any other MDOT property by permitting you to access the Websites. MDOT reserves the right to refuse or cancel any person's access to this site, remove any person from this site or block or otherwise prohibit any person from using this site for any reason whatsoever.

FURTHER LIMITATIONS ON USE

You may not use contact information provided on the site for unauthorized purposes, including marketing.
