**Project Description:** Update the Statewide Long-Range Transportation Plan and the Statewide Transportation Asset Management Plan for MDOT and update the Metropolitan Transportation Plans for Jackson MPO, Hattiesburg MPO, and Gulf Coast MPO – Statewide.

**Question #1: Is the Project Manager required to show licensure as a Mississippi Professional Engineer?**

**Answer:** Yes. Per Part 2, Section II.C.2.a.iii of the RFP, “The PROPOSAL should include proof that the Project Manager is licensed as a Mississippi Professional Engineer in the appendix. Mississippi registration is not required to propose on the PROJECT but is required prior to commencing the work. If the Project Manager is in the process of obtaining this license, that information should be provided.”

**Question #2: How many total copies of the proposal are to be submitted to MDOT?**

**Answer:** Per Part 1, Section X of the RFP, “To be considered, six (6) copies and one (1) CD/flash drive containing electronic PDF file(s) of the CONSULTANT’s PROPOSAL must be received by the date and time indicated in Part 1, Section XXIII. Procurement Schedule,...”

**Question #3: Does one (1) copy need to be identified as “Original” on the cover and do the remaining five (5) copies need to be identified as “Copy” on the cover?**

**Answer: No. Six (6) total printed proposals and one (1) CD/flash drive are to be submitted to MDOT.**

**Question #4: Does the cover letter count against the 20-page limit?**

**Answer: No. Per Part 2, Section I of the RFP, " The cover letter, table of contents, and appendices will not count against the 20-page limit."**
