

Questions and Answers, Part 1 – Traffic Data Services IDIQ Master Contract 2025

Project Description: Provide traffic data services – Statewide.

Question #1: How many volume and classification counts are expected to be ordered per year under the referenced Master Contract?

Answer: Approximately 3,200-4,100 volume counts and approximately 1,300-1,500 classification counts are expected to be ordered per year.

Question #2: What is the anticipated amount of volume and classification type counts and weigh-in-motion calibration that is desired respectively on an annual basis and/or per contract?

Answer: MDOT collects approximately 15,100 counts on a 3-year cycle. Over the last 3 years, an average of approximately 3,500 volume and approximately 1,400 classification counts were collected annually. The anticipated number of weigh-in-motion calibrations has not been determined at this time.

Question #3: Has a DBE goal been established for this Master Contract?

Answer: Per Part 1, Section XVI of the RFP, “The MDOT is committed to provide for full participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) in contracting opportunities available through this IDIQ Master Contract, to the greatest extent practical. DBE goals may be applied to a Work Assignment at MDOT’s discretion. In the event that a DBE goal is required on an individual Work Assignment, MDOT approval of the DBE subconsultant(s) will be required.”

Question #4: Who is defined as Key Personnel for this advertisement?

Answer: Per Part 2, Section II.C.1 of the RFP, “Key Personnel include the Project Manager.”
