**Question #1: Do the front and back covers count toward the 15-page limit?**

**Answer: No.**

**Question #2: How many total copies of the proposal are to be submitted to MDOT?**

**Answer: Per Part 1, Section X of the RFP, “To be considered, nine (9) copies and one (1) flash drive containing electronic PDF file(s) of the CONSULTANT’s PROPOSAL must be received by the date and time indicated in Part 1, Section XXIII. Procurement Schedule.”**

**Question #3: Does one (1) copy need to be identified as “Original” on the cover and do the remaining eight (8) copies need to be identified as “Copy” on the cover?**

**Answer: No. Nine (9) total printed proposals and one (1) flash drive are to be submitted to MDOT in accordance with the RFP.**

**Question #4:** Part 3 Section II.27., of the RFP, lists value engineering services. What are the requirements for the value engineering team to perform these services? Are there any specific certifications required to perform these services?
