Typical Cargoes

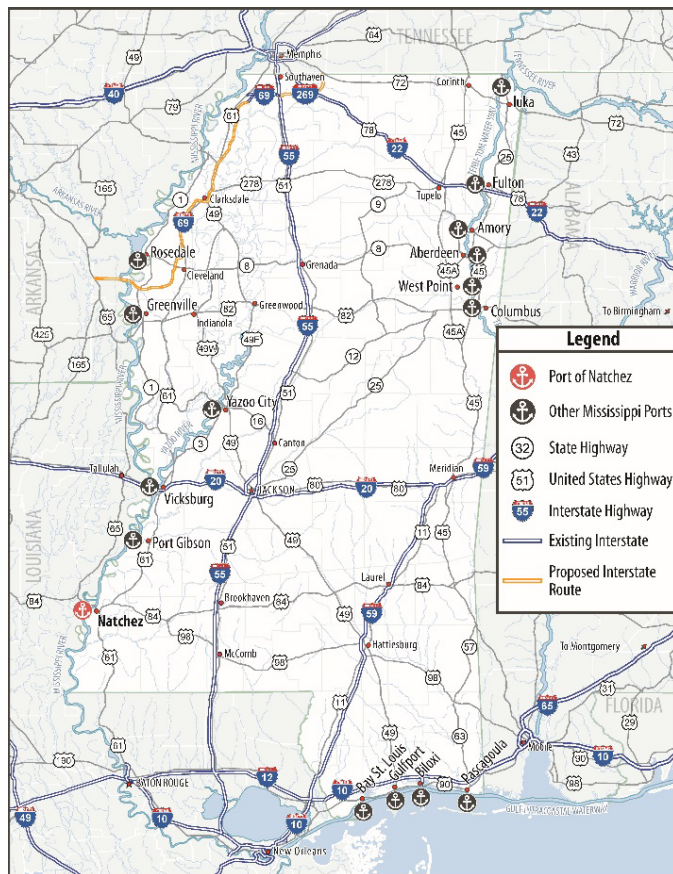
