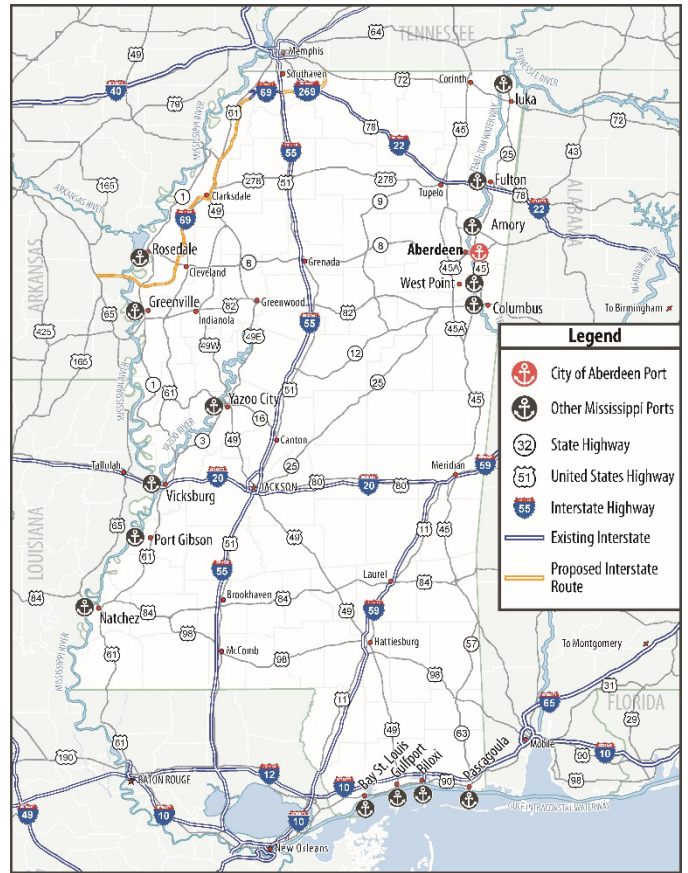


Port of Aberdeen

Connectivity

Road: I-22 thirty miles north via US 45
Rail: Plans to construct a spur to Class 1 KCS one mile from port

Facilities

Two docks, hard surface loading area, mooring structures, mobile crane, warehouse, truck scales

Typical Cargoes

General cargo, limestone, potash, bentonite clay, wood products, and petroleum

Services

Bulk loading/unloading, truck/liquid barge service, cargo equipment handling, drayage, mooring assistance, stevedoring, and towing

Available Land

75 acres committed to operations of the port; 50 acres of undeveloped land at the port site; 175 acres near the port for development; potential land for industrial property across the river from the port
