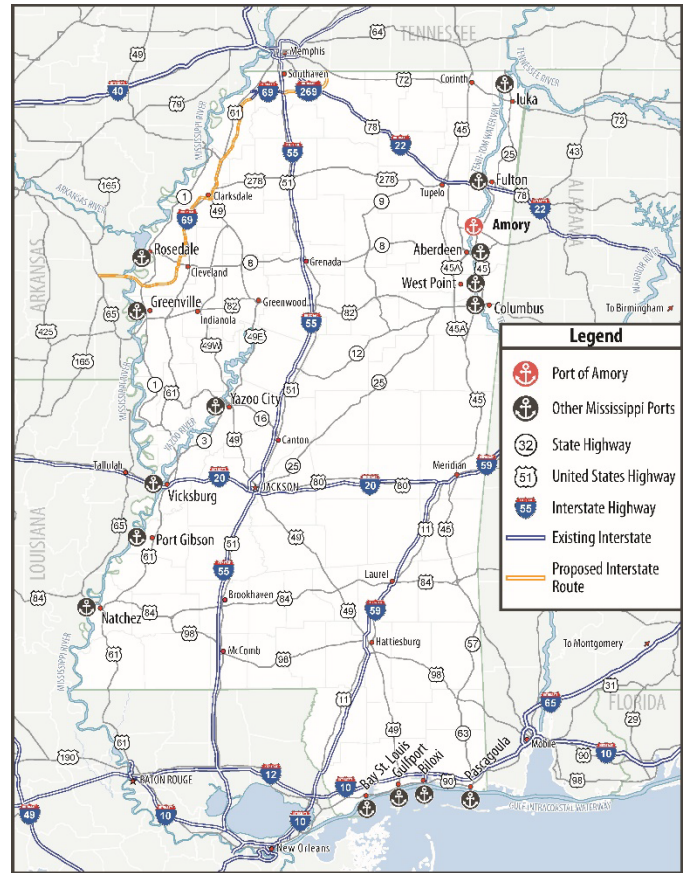


Port of Amory



Three Site Locations:

202 Waterway Drive North - Amory North Port Rail Site has 23 acres with direct access to BNSF rail spurs, all utilities, and port.
Hwy 278 West – Amory Port South Site has 310 acres total with 100 acres owned by the City of Amory. Utilities and port access are located here.
100 Waterway Drive North – Amory Port North Site has 174 acres with all utilities, BNSF rail access, and port access.

Connectivity

Roads: One-half mile from US Highway 278; 8 miles from four-lane US 45
Rail: Direct access to Class 1 BN via port rail spur

Facilities

Public terminal with 800 ft of notched, bulkhead barge berthing area, 7 domes of storage, unpaved open storage, bridge crane

Typical Cargoes

Wood chips, wood pellets, rock salt, soybeans, ore, pet coke, calcined sand, steel, gravel, and raw materials for chemical industry

Services

Barge loading/unloading, general freight transfer including grain and lumber, barge fleet, storage, mooring assistance

Available Land

1200 acres available for future development within the port area
