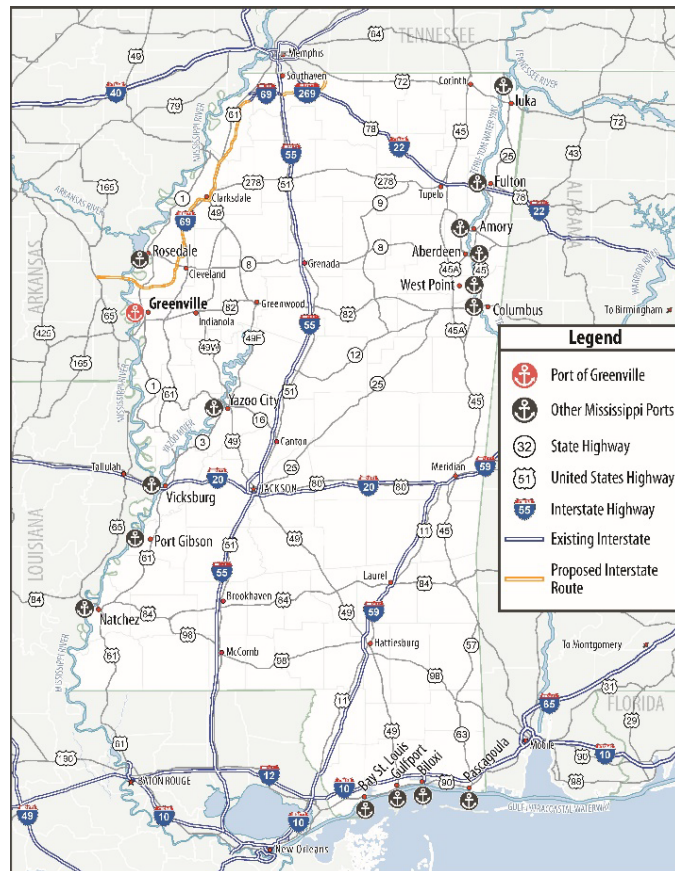


Port of Greenville

Connectivity

Road: Served by US 82/278 (east-west) and MS 1 (two-lane, north-south); US 82 connects to US-61 10 miles east
Rail: 15 miles of port rail connects to CAGY in Greenville and runs to Greenwood for interchange with Class 1 CN rail

Facilities

General cargo & barge dock; warehouse space, enclosed; open storage or staging, hard surface; rail car storage area; liquid storage or transfer; overhead bridge crane; material handling forklifts, track-mobile, front-end loader; bulk dock with loading conveyor; barge fleetling, open storage or staging, soft surface; bulk storage or transfer; transload dock; mobile crane; truck scales

Typical Cargoes

Bulk, break-bulk and project cargo; rice; winter wheat; corn; soybeans; petroleum products; frac sand; chemicals; scrap steel

Services

Barge loading/unloading/transloading; harbor and fleetling services; marine dry-dock and repair; open yard hard stand storage; warehousing; all-weather transloading with covered bridge crane; transloading between rail, truck and barge; truck scales
