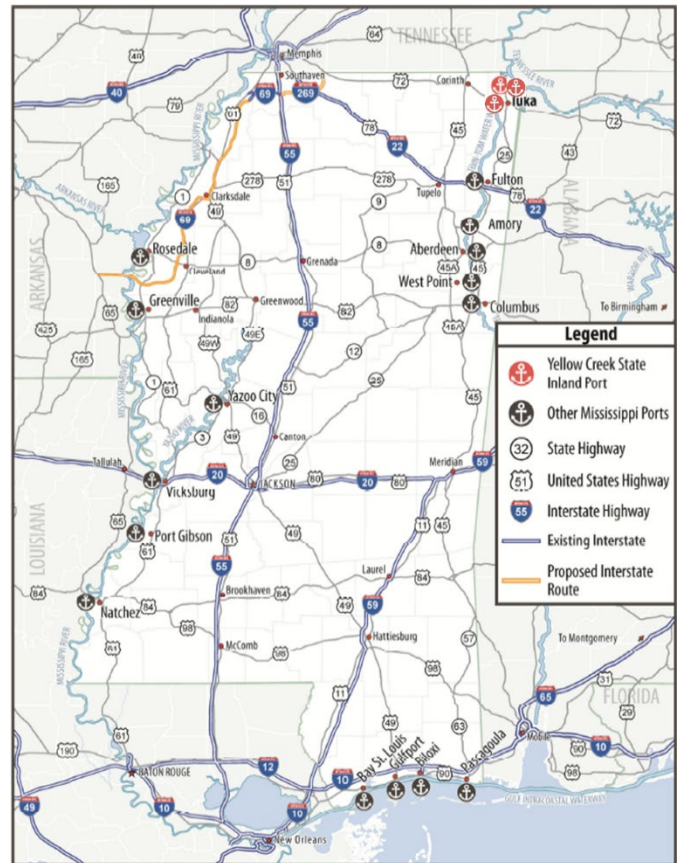


Yellow Creek State Inland Port
