# Bell Ringer: Determine an author's point of view

Grade Level: 9-10

**Duration:** 15-20 minutes **Lesson Description**:

- 1. The teacher will pass out the worksheet "Proper Seatbelt Use," or access it online at <a href="https://www.adtsea.org">www.adtsea.org</a>.
- 2. Students will read the article, paying special attention to the author's purpose and textual evidence to support this purpose.
- 3. After reading the article, students will answer each two part question showing mastery of knowledge from the text.
- 4. Students will use textual evidence from the article to write a paragraph in Question 1 Part A proving why there is no excuse not to wear a seatbelt.
